

## **A Single-Party State**



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### **Characteristics of a Single Party State**

- 1. Control the masses through fear/terror or loyalty
- 2. Use propaganda to show how your ideology will get your people to "the top."
- 3. Secret police
- 4. Military control
- 5. Clandestine intelligence agency
- 6. Seize power through military coup
- Get rid of opposition (likely by force) & legislate by decree
- 8. Control media, education & civil liberties

## **Structure of the Soviet State**

- <u>**Dual Authority**</u> Communist Party is "dictatorship exercised by a private body"
  - Marx no political structure
  - Applied Bolshevik Party org. to whole country
  - Democratic institutions are maintained, but had to become Bolshevik loyalists
- <u>Cheka</u> Secret police force





## **State-Building**

- 1. Destroy everything from before (military, economics, political instututions) "SMASH!"
- 2. Construct a new order free from Soviets/Constituent Assembly→ absolutism (took 6 mos.)
- 3. Communist Party (born Mar.1918) remained private, though they controlled everything
- 4. Central Committee (highest branch of Party, born Mar. 1919)
  - Politburo Decisionmaking
  - --- Orgburo -- Personnel development




- 5. Lenin was dictator & Sovnarkom (executive) approved decisions
- 6. Russia returns to 33 self-governing principalities w/ Communist support (like pre-Romanov)
- 7. Mar. 1918 Constitution Weak, anarchist, doesn't mention Communists (basically, a joke)
- 8. Sovnarkom now responsible to Central Committee of Party, neither of which Lenin listened to, exemplified by "Constitutional crisis" over the press
  - $\rightarrow$  Back to pre-Duma days of 1905 w/Lenin as dictator



#### **Resistance**

- Intelligentsia (Pipes: got what they deserve for breaking down old order)
- Walkouts (Trotsky)
- Refusal for money by state banks for Bolsheviks



But I am the new Foreign Minister!

(ironic laughter)

### **Bolshevik Answers**

- "Bolsheviks would neither share power, nor surrender it." (158)
- Replace workers w/ junior officials until strikers realize the Bolsheviks aren't going anywhere
- Bank robbery by armed guards



## **Constituent Assembly Issues**

- Directly elected body; last bastion of PG
- Bolsheviks win in Nov. 1917 elections, but not in cities (Kadets liberals!)→
- Lenin outlaws Kadets (of course he does.)



# **Communism in the Balance**

- Bolsheviks recruit Latvian riflemen
- Once CA opened, Bolsheviks booed & aimed guns @ opposition leaders
- Ask the CA to renounce its own authority to Bolshevik decrees → No → Bolsheviks leave.
- Within hours, troops entered CA & disbanded it → Pravda linked CA to American Capitalism (\*first time US used negatively\*)



### <u>Aftermath</u>

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Congress of Soviets opens in place of CA
  - 94% Bolshevik; Immediately declares all decrees law of the land→ now permanent government of Russia
- Socialist intellectuals: Candles & sandwiches instead of guns; "Better to let the CA die a quiet death than provoke a civil war" (164)
- Spring 1918: If you don't succeed, have more "elections"
  - Disqualified Mensheviks & SRs from running
